Friday Tours

Our branch members will provide rides to/from each tour, except for the Walking Tour for which we will provide a ride to the starting point only. All tours are 1 hour to 1 ½ hours long. Please reserve your preferred tour on this form so we can accommodate you by making a reservation for the tour and by arranging transportation. A limited number of spaces are available.

- Guided Historical Walking Tour of Kailua Town A car will leave the hotel at 1:45 PM taking you to the start point of this fascinating tour. Led by a member of the Kona Historical Society, you will explore the history of Kailua Town, including stops at Kamakahonu (the final residence of King Kamehameha I), Mokuaikaua (the first Christian church in Hawaii), and Hulihe'e Palace (the summer vacation home of royalty). The walking tour is free, but a docent-led tour inside the palace may be available for \$10. It is currently being renovated, so we will let you know ASAP if this is an option.
- Greenwell Farms Leaves the hotel at 2 PM. You will tour this historic coffee farm and learn about the contributions of the Greenwell family to Kona through the years. Tasting included. No fee, but you may want to buy coffee!
- **3. Big Island Bees** Leaves the hotel at 1:15 PM to attend the 2 PM tour, learning about the life of bees, beekeeping, and sampling products made from their honey. With a Hawaiian ID, the fee is \$8; without ID it is \$10. You will pay at the bee farm.
- **4.** Kona Brewing Company Leaves the hotel at 2:45 PM to take 3 PM tour. Learn about the brewing process and the varieties of beer created in the Kona facility. Tour includes a commemorative gift and 4 samples of beer. Send \$10 when making this reservation.
